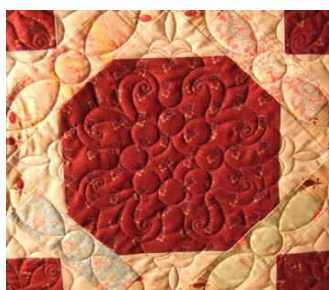
I would also like to take this opportunity to say a big thankyou for all of you have supported me in my new venture. I love creating patterns and I love that you all love them too...

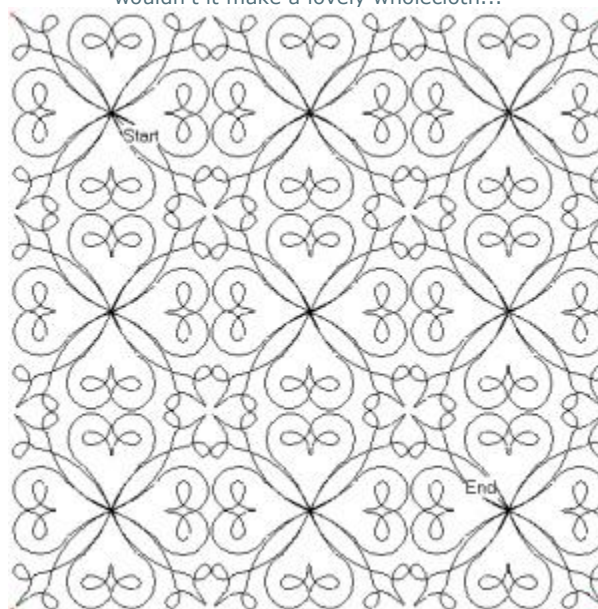
