Why not try repeating the triangle twice to make up one large triangle !! The beauty with this Japanese bloom pattern below is that it is P2P so it can be quilted in one go!!

When i want to get a pattern up onto the computer to digitize I no long use the scanner... it is so much faster to get the Digital Camera out, take a picture and up load it straight on to your computer... Then it is easy to drop into Autosketch to trace.
